

# Crossover Crazies

## PROJECT 1

It's easy to incorporate several techniques into a fun and easy project. The benefits are appealing to a broader range of interests and use a wider range of products.

### Supplies

Accent Factory Metal Findings (corners and charms)  
Delta Ceramcoat: Avocado, Chamomile, Olive Yellow, Espresso, Light Ivory, Gold Iridescent Gold Glaze,  
Paint for Paper Silver  
Delta Sobo Craft Glue  
Delta Sparkle Glaze  
FM Brushes (no. 1 liner, nos. 4 and 8 flats, fan brush)  
Gold-colored textured paper  
Gold cord  
Strathmore Picture Frame Cards (no. 105-705, 5-by-6 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches)  
Rubber Stampede Bugs Desk Set (no. 701 60, sponge daubers)  
Stencil Magic Paint Cream Gold, Copper



### Frame

1. Paint Chamomile.
2. Use the sponge dauber to tint with Stencil Magic Paint Crème and/or Paint for Paper Silver.
3. Spatter with Chamomile or Silver using the fan brush.
4. Stamp using the Bug Set. Press the stamp into the wet tints to lift the paint OR use the Stencil Magic Paint Cream or stamp pad. Have fun and experiment.

### Insert

1. Paint a 1-inch circle in the center, about two-thirds from the bottom, with Espresso using the no. 8 flat.
2. Use the no. 4 flat to paint the petals around the center with Chamomile.
3. Use the liner brush to paint the stem to the bottom with Avocado.
4. Refer to the photo to draw two leaf shapes by the stem. Connect to leaves to the stems with lines. Paint the stems Avocado and the leaves Olive Yellow.
5. Sideload the no. 8 flat with Avocado. Paint at the base of the leaves to shade.
6. Use the liner brush to paint veins with Chamomile.
7. Paint over the center and petals with Sparkle Glaze.

### Finish

1. Attach the painting to the inside of the frame with Sobo Craft Glue.
2. Attach frame embellishments to corners of the opening.
3. Punch holes in the edge to attach cord and charms.
